PLEASE READ BEFORE CAMPING!

- 1. EVERYONE** camping or visiting must register in the Lodge before occupying a campsite. We need to know in advance how many will be at each site for best site selection.
- 2. AN ADULT MUST BE WITH CHILDREN WALKING DOGS.** Due to safety, liability and peoples' fear factor, ALL pets must be non-aggressive, have proof of required shots, kept quiet, physically restrained on a hand-held leash, picnic table leg or ground stake, not a tree. Do not leave pets out while away. Dog waste is unsanitary and transmits disease! Use a bag to pick up pet waste and put it in a container at your site or a pet waste station along our roads.
- 3. SPEED LIMIT (10 MPH).** Park vehicles where they will not overcrowd campsites.
- 4. AVOID INJURING TREES.** Carefully wrap clothes lines or canopy ropes around mature trees only, not bendable branches or young trees. **HAMMOCK USE BY PERMISSION ONLY.**
- 5. DO NOT PICK UP, PULL UP, CUT OR BREAK TREES, BRANCHES OR PLANTS** at campsites or elsewhere on our property. Doing so can damage our natural setting. We have dry firewood and/or fire starters for sale at reasonable cost. **NO PALLET BURNING.**
- 6. CONTROL CAMPFIRE(s)** up to knee high in the fire ring where it is. Use care to avoid accidents or damage by fire or sparks. A fire burns best when air can enter under it. Keep water to control and put out fires by midnight and whenever no one is at the campsite. It is against the law to transport firewood from out of state to avoid infestation of VT trees.
- 7. ADULTS MUST ACTIVELY SUPERVISE CHILDREN** for their safety. Please, prevent them from dislodging or throwing stones or injuring themselves playing in our ponds or brooks.
- 8. PLACE TRASH, RECYCLABLES,** deposit bottles and uncrushed deposit cans in marked containers at campsite, dump station or in front of Lodge. Keep sites clean. Rakes are available.
- 9. SOME PROPANE STOVES BURN TABLE TOPS.** Place where they won't cause damage.
- 10. BE CONSIDERATE.** Keep conversation, radios & other noise low, especially 10 PM - 8 AM.
- 11. LEGAL/RESPONSIBLE USE OF ALCOHOL AT CAMPSITES ONLY. NO DRUGS!**
- 12. ALL RECREATION** including a common room for socializing, reading, games, TV, Wi-Fi, swimming, (no life guard), boating/canoeing sign-out/sign-in are available at no cost. **EVERY ONE MUST WEAR A LIFE JACKET WHEN BOATING OR CANOEING.** Our game room has table tennis, air hockey, shuffleboard, foosball, sink, microwave oven & eating table; use 7AM to 9:30 PM. (Use of the upstairs hostel kitchen is for guests staying in the hostel only!)
- 13. AN ADULT 18 YRS OR OLDER** must sign for the use of our boat, canoe, life jacket, oars and paddles. Print name, date, time out & time in. *Please report any damage or maintenance needs.*
- 14. BATHROOMS AND NO PAY SHOWERS ARE IN THE LODGE.** Conserve water; dry off in the shower. Please inform us of any problems – toilets, wet floors; use quietly 10 PM to 8 AM.

15. BY LAW, waste water including porta pottie, sink and shower water must be emptied into a container, not on the ground, and disposed of at a sanitary dump station. We loan containers.

16. NO PLIERS! HAND TIGHTEN/LOOSEN YOUR RV HOSE ONLY! If the screen in your pressure restrictor keeps your hose from tightening, pry the screen out and turn it over.

17. CONSERVE WATER especially if washing and rinsing RVs or vehicles. \$5 charge for each.

18. USE OF OUR FACILITIES IS AT INDIVIDUAL RISK. The owners and staff of Greenwood Lodge and Campsites assume no liability for accidents, injuries, death or loss of any kind. Keep all personal property items secure from theft or damage by unexpected wind or rain.

19. PROMPTLY REPORT ANYTHING WE SHOULD ATTEND TO ASAP.
